Government Policy on Free Tertiary Education

* In January 2019, Government decided to provide free tertiary education level courses (award Certificate, Diploma and Degree) run on full time or part time mode by Public Education Institutions (PEIs). The scheme covers tuition fees for students of Mauritian Nationality enrolled in a recognized **first** award certificate, **first** diploma and **first** degree programme on either full-time, part-time mode. This exemption will apply for payment of tuition fees, **only** administrative fees and registration fees will be paid by the students.

SADC Countries tuition fees will be applicable to local students not eligible to the above scheme.

** Pearson Registration fees are subject to change without prior notice.
