### MOBILITY OPPORTUNITIES WITHIN KA171 PROJECTS AT THE ACADEMY OF SILESIA

The Academy of Design and Innovation (ADI) is pleased to announce the Mobility Opportunities within the Erasmus+ KA171 Project in collaboration with the Academy of Silesia, Poland. This opportunity offers eligible graduates the chance to undertake a **five-month mobility programme**, enabling them to gain valuable international academic experience in a dynamic European environment while enhancing their academic, professional, and intercultural competencies.

#### 1. Eligible Candidates / Eligible Programmes

Applications are open to students who have successfully completed one of the following programmes of study in **2025 or 2026** and who are **not currently enrolled in any other programme at the Academy of Design and Innovation (ADI)**.

- Pearson Level 5 Higher National Diploma (HND) in Art and Design (Fashion) / BA (Hons) Fashion and Textiles (Top-up)
- Pearson Level 5 Higher National Diploma (HND) in Art and Design (Graphic Design) / BA (Hons) Graphic Design with Animation (Top-up)
- BA (Hons) Interior Design

#### 2. Place of selection:

Conference Room, Academy of Design and Innovation, Ebene

#### 3. Date/ time:

#### 4. Selection criteria:

To promote both academic excellence and social inclusion, the Academy of Design and Innovation (ADI) will select a **total of six (6) students**, comprising **two (2) students from each of the above-mentioned eligible programmes**.

The six (6) mobility places will be allocated under the following categories:

1. **Merit-Based Selection** – One (1) student from each eligible programme will be selected based on academic merit, commitment, and overall performance.
2. **Inclusion and Social Support Selection** – One (1) student from each eligible programme will be selected based on the same Selection Criteria, with additional consideration given to the applicant's financial or socio-economic circumstances and recognised social vulnerabilities, where supported by appropriate documentary evidence.

All applicants will be assessed based on the following:

- Academic performance and overall academic progress.
- Commitment to studies, attendance, and participation in academic activities.
- Communication and interpersonal skills.
- Conduct, discipline, and professional behaviour.
- Motivation to participate in the Erasmus+ KA171 Mobility Programme and the potential to benefit from the international learning experience.
- Adaptability, maturity, and ability to represent the Academy of Design and Innovation (ADI) in an international environment.

For applicants applying under the **Inclusion and Social Support Selection** category, the Selection Committee will additionally consider the applicant's financial or socio-economic circumstances and recognised social vulnerabilities, where supported by appropriate documentary evidence.

- Curriculum Vitae (CV) in Europass format
- Copy of valid Passport
- Letter of Motivation (maximum one page)
- Academic Transcript and Certificate
- Applicants applying under the Inclusion and Social Support Category must additionally submit documentary evidence supporting their financial or social circumstances, where applicable
