## **Government Policy on Free Tertiary Education**

\* In January 2019, Government decided to provide free tertiary education level courses (award Certificate, Diploma and Degree) run on full time or part time mode by Public Education Institutions (PEIs). This exemption will apply for payment of tuition fees, **only** administrative fees and registration fees will be paid by the students.
